Territorial Energy Strategy

Since 1997, the Green Road Village program is paving the way for Nagypáli's energy transition, shaping public policies and projects. At its core, the promotion of renewable energies, a rational use of energy, sustainable tourism, community building, environmental protection and awareness and local products. Based on the social, economic, infrastructural and financial situation, the program supports a local resource-based economy for a sustainable and resilient village.



Energy uses

Not limited to the production of renewable energy, Nagypáli developed projects to better address energy uses, in particular mobility challenges. An eco-bus, electric bikes, solar charging stations for electric cars: giving citizens alternatives to the usual fossil fuel driven individual car.

Investment in solar power

Since 2012, the rooftops of community buildings are systematically built using solar panels. Solar, both thermal and PV cover a large part of the energy costs in community buildings and the energy is also available to local residents.

The "Sunflower Solar Cell" of the village was 1st built and became emblematic of the village's commitment.
